On Friday, July 17, 2015, ARTsmart President Connie Axton accepted a donation of \$11,600 to ARTsmart's scholarship fund from Inn of the Governors, a lodging facility located in downtown Santa Fe. On this occasion, Axton said, "Scholarships are critically important to serving our mission to provide enriching programming to all youth in Northern New Mexico. We are grateful to Inn of the Governors for supporting our meaningful outreach to at-risk youth."

According to Samuel Gerberding, General Manager, Inn of the Governors, "We are delighted to be working with ARTsmart, both as a business partner fostering Santa Fe's unique appeal and as a community partner serving our local needs."
